



SISTERS, SERVANTS OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

OUR LADY OF PEACE RESIDENCE
SCRANTON, PENNSYLVANIA

Located in Scranton, Pennsylvania, Our Lady of Peace Residence is a 133,000 square foot continuing care retirement community operated by the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The four-story facility, designed and built by Hoffman, replaced Marian Convent, the previous home to 130 elderly Sisters. Designed to provide a homelike setting, the convent ministers to the wellness needs of the Sisters and offers a shared Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) center for Scranton residents. In addition to three household wings—each con-

taining 10 resident units—Our Lady of Peace Residence features a public “main street” which has a chapel, beauty salon, bistro, and dining services. Administrative space for the congregation is also centrally located. Site features include private and secure landscaped courtyards for the Sisters and quiet meditative areas and paths on the grounds.
