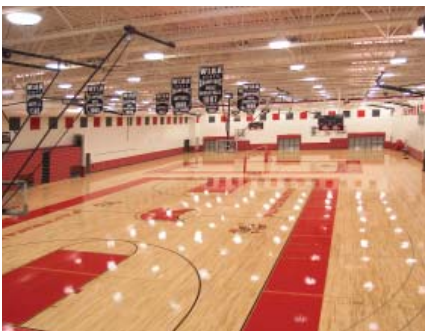

Determined to address the space shortage they were experiencing, the Kimberly Area School District in Wisconsin asked Hoffman to perform a facilities assessment of its schools and conduct pre-referendum services. When they district decided that designing and building a new high school was the wisest, long-term solution, they again looked to Hoffman. Kimberly High School, a 254,000 square foot facility with capacity for 1,100 students, features a dual interior/exterior commons with an open balcony, a two-story library, a 742-seat auditorium, a four-station

gymnasium, and a two-story weight room and fitness area for both school and community use. The creation of Kimberly High School allowed the school district to create additional space by reconfiguring the make-up of its existing facilities.
