



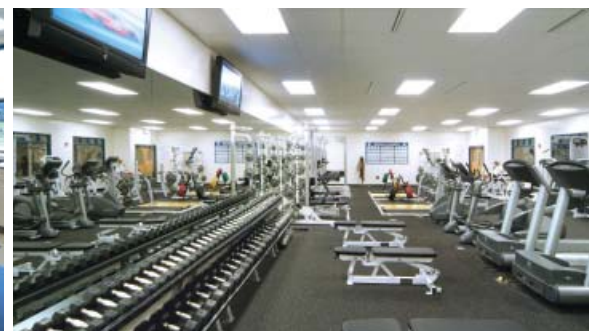

The Nekoosa School District in Wisconsin looked to Hoffman to evaluate and assess the district's facilities and then oversee the 39,500 square feet worth of additions and renovations to its high school. Hoffman's design and construction addressed the lack of appropriate handicap accessibility as well as the highly energy-inefficient HVAC system found within the multi-level high school. A handicap-accessible elevator and entrances were featured in the renovation, as was the complete upgrade of the HVAC system to an energy-efficient model with a modern digital control

system. Student-centered additions to the existing school included a gymnasium, fitness/training room, and a modern science laboratory, which provides increased learning opportunities for students.
