Notre Dame Academy in Green Bay, Wisconsin, looked to Hoffman when they decided to renovate their outdated, 960-seat auditorium, which also serves as their worship space for school liturgies. One of the main areas of the school that hadn't undergone a significant renovation, the auditorium's interior was old and had a muted, gray interior, while its primary entrance was nondescript and blended into the school corridor. The school hoped to create an inspiring, colorful, and vibrant environment—ideal for both theatrical performances

and worship services—to be enjoyed by students, staff, parents, and the public. A wood proscenium arch that now frames the stage highlighted the remodel, in addition to other efforts such as the installation of sconces and new carpet and paint that reflect school colors. The auditorium's primary entrance was enhanced with dark green wall-covering and a wood canopy that emphasizes the entry doors and conceals cove lighting that supplements new light fixtures.

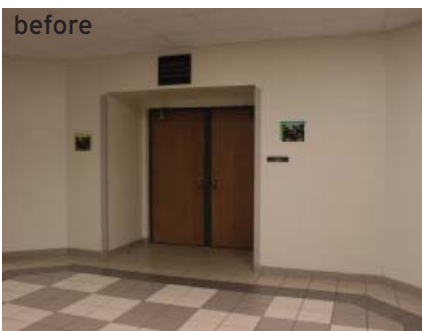
